Baby is a sweetheart. She did wonderfully well for her first visit with us. She weighs 2.19 pounds. She is about 8 to 9 weeks old. Her ears and eyes are fine and clear; no sign of infection; no ear mites. Kitten teeth are good. Heart and lungs are clear. Abdomen and joints palpated normal.

One live flea found on her combing; no signs of flea dirt etc... We can check her daily and apply her courtesy kitten Advantge application at the next visit in 2 weeks.

We trimmed her nails --- to get her used to being handled and having nails trimmed.

Her FeLV/FIV test was negative. If she remains indoors only, we may still want to recheck her status once more when she is an adult (next year).

We started her vaccines with the FVRCP ("upper respiratory" vaccine). Let us know if any lethargy or soreness around her left hip. Unless things change and she is exposed to outdoor cats, we can skip her FeLV and rabies vaccines.

We dewormed her for round and hookworms; if she has a lot of worms, you may see them passed in her stool and / or vomit.

Please call if you have any questions or concerns. Unless problems, schedule a treatment appointment in 2 weeks for her second deworming and Advantage application. Next exam in 3-4 weeks for her second FVRCP vaccine..tnt
