Client Notes for Bella Greenwood for 06/20/09: Bella's Weight: 1.94 Lbs

Bella is a sweetie. She weighs 1.94 pounds and is about 7-8 weeks old. We applied the eye drops as requested at 12 noon today. The skin scrapes around her ears and head were positive for feline scabies. Her ears tested negative for ear mites. It is possible she HAD ear mites but not now. Regardless, the ivermectin for the scabies will also be effective for the ear mites. We gave an ivermectin injection today; a second injection is needed in 2 weeks.

We called Eye Care for Animals and confirmed that Bella does not need to stay on oral Clavamox. Just keep her on the eye drops as prescribed.

We postponed her vaccines until next visit.

If she has not been tested for FeLV / FIV, we can do that at the next visit.

Please review the information on feline scabies. It is contagious to other pets and people. Let us know if you have any questions or concerns.

Unless problems, schedule a treatment appointment in 2 weeks for the second ivermectin injection, start her vaccines, and second deworming...tnt
