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### **Client Notes for Bunny Puente for 06/10/09: Bunny's Weight: 10.56 Lbs**

Bunny did very well for her first visit with us. She weighs 10.56 pounds. She has quite a few fleas that are likely the cause of the itching and hairloss on her back. We applied Frontline Plus today and will address the skin problem if still present after flea control.

She has a ruptured left anal gland. Please review the information on anal glands and let us know if you have any questions. We clipped and cleaned the abscess and started her on oral antibiotic. Next dose due this evening:

Rx: Clavamox Drops -- Give 1 ml by mouth twice daily as directed until finished. Antibiotic. Keep refrigerated..tnt

\*\*\* Discontinue medication and call us if any GI upset such as vomiting and diarrhea.

Rx: Chlorhex Flush --- Clean wound by left anal gland with moistened cotton balls twice daily as needed to keep clean; until follow-up in a week...tnt

Apply a warm compress to the abscess (if she lets you) twice daily for 5-10 minutes for the next 2 days.

We are sending the rest of the Frontline package to be used on the other cats.

Please call if any problems with her treatment.

Unless problems, schedule a follow-up in 7-10 days; update her vaccines and recheck her flea control; bring fecal sample..tnt
