Cherry did very well for her first visit with us; she weighs 10.13 pounds and is in good body condition.

She has a left "cherry eye", a prolapsed gland of the third eyelid. It is mild and not causing her problems at this time. However, she may need eye ointment and/or surgery to repair the cherry eye if worsens. Monitor for eye discharge and/or if the gland is prolapsed all the time.

Ears look good; no sign of infection.

She has a retained right lower puppy canine that should be extracted to allow the adult canine to grow in properly.

Heart and lungs are clear; no murmur and no congestion.

Abdomen palpated normal.

She has a lot of fleas. Please let us know if you have any flea control questions. Best to keep her on monthly Frontline Plus.

Monitor her stool for signs of tapeworms (from the fleas).

We dewormed her for round and hookworms. You may see them passed in her vomit or stool. Save a sample for us to identify if any noted.

Have her spayed within the next 2-3 months (before she goes in heat again).

We gave the rabies vaccine on her left hip; let us know if any lethargy or soreness.

Unless problems, schedule a treatment appointment for her second deworming and distemper-parvo vaccine.
