Client Notes for Cricket Webb for 06/18/09:

Cricket's Weight: 7.32 Lbs

Cricket gained an ounce in the past year and is at 7.32 pounds today. Her ears and eyes are fine; no sign of infection. Her teeth have mild dental tartar. Try to do home dental care (rubbing her teeth and brushing them with a pet enzymatic paste as discussed. Otherwise, she will likely need a dental cleaning in a year or 2.

Heart and lungs are clear.

Abdomen palpated normal.

She has a scab, non-healing sore on her right shoulder. The sore may be not healing due to her scratching. It could also be due to the inflammatory skin condition she had last year --- possibly even allergy-related if she continues to have this skin problem every summer/fall.

No fleas found.

Since it is difficult to give her oral medication, we will start her on topical medication like last time:

Rx: Tresaderm --- Apply 1-2 drops to the area twice daily for 2 weeks... Keep out of eyes. Keep Refrigerated..tnt

At this time, her skin problems appear inflammatory and may be behavior related, Since she improved with the amitriptyline last time, find the amitriptyline and restart her on it as follows:

Rx: Amitriptyline transdermal gel 100mg /1ml --- Apply 0.05 ml to inner ear as directed once daily.

*** Let us know if you need a refill prescription.

We submitted blood and urine for her wellness screen. She was good for the sample collection.

We updated her FVRCP vaccine on her right hip. Let us know if any soreness or lethargy.

Please call for lab results on Sunday; sooner if problems.

Unless problems, schedule follow-up in 3 weeks...tnt
