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Client Notes for Cubby Smith for 06/21/09: Cubby's Weight: 62.6 Lbs

Cubby lost almost 2 pounds in the past 3 months; he looks good at 62.6 pounds. Continue working with his weight management to get him to about 60 pounds and re-assess.

His left ear has a large wax plug that may have contributed to the head shaking. Mild wax build-up present in both ears but no apparent sign of infection. We cleaned both ears and removed the wax plug from the left ear. Start cleaning his ears as directed with Alocetic Ear Rinse twice a week to monitor. If he continues to shake his head / scratch his ears or excessive discharge noted, we may need to add on topical ear medication.

Rx: Alocetic Ear Rinse -- Clean both ears with moistened cotton balls as directed twice a week for maintenance..tnt

Both of his anal glands were very full. We emptied them both.

OK to stay with Authority dry if he is doing well with it. Can try gradually switching from Pedigree pouches to canned Science Diet Sensitive Skin formula. Monitor and let us know if soft stool or problems with diet change.

Keep him on the flea control, vitamin supplements and following medications:

- 1) 3V Caps 1 once daily
- 2) PhyCox Chews 1 per day
- 3) Chlorpheniramine 4 mg - 2 tablets once daily.
- 4) Tramadol HCl 50 mg: - 1 tablet once daily.

Unless problems, schedule a brief consult in 2 weeks to check his ears and update his distemper-parvo vaccine...tnt
