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Client Notes for Dash Ward for 06/13/09:

Dash's Weight: 2.5 Lbs

Dash did very well for his first visit with us. He was timid but very cooperative for the procedures. He weighs 2.5 pounds and is about 8 weeks old. He is a male but we were not able to isolate his testicles. We will check him on later visits --- if no testicles palpable or visible in another 3-4 weeks, he may be a cryptorchid (testicles are retained in his abdomen or inguinal area) OR a small chance of someone already neutering him (unlikely but not impossible).

His ears and eyes are clear; no sign of infection or ear mites.

Kitten teeth are fine.

Heart and lungs are clear.

Main problem (other than the non-descended testicles) is the fleas. The scabs on his head are likely from fleas. If no improvement with flea control, we will need to do skin scrapes.

His FeLV/FIV test was negative. We dewormed him for round and hookworms, started his FVRCP vaccine and trimmed his nails. He was great for the procedures.

We also applied a courtesy dose of Advantage.

If he has a lot of worms, you may see him pass it in his vomit or stool. let us know if any noted.

Unless problems, schedule a treatment appointment in 2 weeks for the second deworming for round and hookworms. Monitor him for tapeworms (due to the fleas); if tapeworms noted, we will treat him for that also.
