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Client Notes for Freda Yampolsky for 06/12/09: Freda's Weight: 33.8 Lbs

We extracted 2 large foxtails from Freda's right ear. She is still a little slow from the sedative but is otherwise doing fine. Keep her quiet and confine the rest of the evening; no running or jumping.

Feed her HALF her usual food after 7 pm tonight. Resume normal feeding tomorrow morning. Let us know if she does not want to eat in 24 hours.

No ear cleaning until we see her again.

Do NOT apply any ear medication or get any fluid in her ears.

Start her oral antibiotic this evening:

Rx: Baytril 136 mg --- Give 1/2 tablet by mouth ONCE daily with food. Antibiotic..tnt

*** Discontinue medication and call us if any GI upset such as vomiting or diarrhea.

No foreign body noted in her outer nose. But if she continues to sneeze excessively and/or have discharge from her nose, she may need to have a rhinoscopy to evaluate her nasal passages.

Unless problems, schedule a follow-up for her ear check in 10-14 days..tnt
