Client Notes for Ginger Davis for 06/17/09:

Ginger's Weight: 24.1 Lbs

Ginger lost about 1/2 pound in the past year; she looks good at 24.1 pounds today. OK to continue with her current diet.

Her physical exam was good; no infection noted in her ears. Age related changes to her eyes, making the lens appear cloudy but no cataracts and no problems with her vision.

Moderate dental tartar on her upper premolars. Since we don't want to do general anesthesia on her again for the dentistry, try to work with her mouth and do home dental care. Use the enzymatic dental paste daily as discussed. Start by rubbing her teeth 30 seconds on each side then add on paste and eventually use a soft pet toothbrush.

She is moving very well with the rear legs; no sign of soreness on palpation.

We updated her bordetella vaccine on her right shoulder and her distemper-parvo on her left shoulder.. Let us know if any problems such as lethargy or soreness.

Her anal glands were small. If she continues to hold her tail oddly, we can check the glands again and/or do radiographs to recheck her hips. We also trimmed the front dewclaws.

We submitted blood for her senior wellness. We should have results this weekend.

Unless problems or otherwise indicated by lab results, we will see her in 6 months for the weight check and mouth check (teeth check to see how home dental care is progressing)..tnt
