Huerita has a temperature of 103.5F; a slight fever, likely from yesterday's vaccine. No signs of hives or allergic reaction noted. However, since she was pawing at her face/eyes, we will have her on Benadryl for the next 2-3 days just in case.

Rx: Children's Liquid Benadryl (usually 12.5 mg per teaspoon) -- Give 3/4 teaspoonn by mouth this afternoon (when she gets home) then again around 11 pm.

Continue with the Benadryl tomorrow morning.

Call with an update mid-morning. If she is still not eating, may need to bring her in for another temperature check and medications.

Try giving her shredded boiled chicken (skinless and boneless) and cooked white rice (1 part chicken to 2 parts rice).

If the fever is from the vaccine, she should feel better by tonight or tomorrow morning. We gave some subcutaneous fluids today. The lump between her shoulders should be gone by tonight.
