### ***Client Notes for Kittens Gray for 06/14/09:***

The male kitten weighs 1 pound and appears to be unaffected. The female kitten weighs 0.75 pounds and has slight nasal discharge. Her left eye was closed with mucopurulent discharge. We cleaned the left eye to open it. The eye appears fine beneath the discharge (i.e. no ulceration). She likely is fighting off an upper respiratory infection. Since she is nursing and otherwise doing well, we will treat the eye infection for now. Monitor and let us know any drop in her appetite or if sneezing worsens, we will need to add on antibiotics.

Use Bandit's BNP Ointment. Apply 1/8 inch strip to the female's left eye 3 times a day for 10 days then as directed.

Clean the eyes with a warm moistened cotton balls at least 3 times a day, more often if needed.

In another week, try mixing canne dkitten food with the KMR and introduce them to solid food.

Unless problems, follow-up in 7-10 days to check eyes (if you still have them)..tnt
