Client Notes for Kitty Guerry for 06/21/09: Kitty's Weight: 2.5 Lbs

Kitty is a sweetheart. She weighs 2.5 pounds and is about 8 to 9 weeks old. She has some slight clear discharge from both eyes and nose. No sneezing noted during the exam. Her temperature is normal at 101.4F. However, the discharge is indicative of an upper respiratory infection; she may be recovering from one (or coming down with one). We dewormed her for round and hookworms today but will postpone her vaccines until next visit.

Her FeLV / FIV test was negative.

Flea dirt was found; we applied a courtesy dose of Advantage for flea control.

Start her on the lysine supplement for the upper respiratory signs. Monitor and let us know if any sneezing.

Rx: L-Lysine Granules --- Mix 1/2 scoop in food twice daily as directed (at least until next visit). Anti-viral supplement..tnt

Upper respiratory infection is contagious among cats. If you can't keep Kitty away from Freddy, then monitor Freddy for any sneezing or upper respiratory signs (eye discharge, etc).

Unless problems, schedule a treatment appointment in 2 weeks for her second deworming and start her vaccines..tnt
