Kobe still has a slight fever of 103.5F. We gave him an antibiotic injection with vitamin B-12 in hope of stimulating his appetite. Since he is fighting the liquid Clavamox, we can try the tablets for him:

Rx: Clavamox 62.5 mg --- Give 1/2 tablet by mouth twice daily --- starts tomorrow morning.

Get pediatric neosynephrine nasal drops and apply 1/2 to 1 drop to each nostril ONCE daily for the next 2-3 days. Do not apply more than 3 days. Let us know if you have problems finding the nose drops (not as easily available as before). If he starts eating on his own, no nasal drops needed.

Syringe feed as discussed. About 1 syringe of AD every 4 hours.

Please call with update tomorrow. If unable to feed him or if worsens, he needs to be hospitalized -- preferably at a 24 hr facility. We can keep him here if you are unable to take him to a 24 hr facility. Feeding tube may be needed..tnt
