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Client Notes for Oso Flores for 06/12/09:

Oso's Weight: 6 Lbs

Oso did very well for his first puppy visit. He weighs 6 pounds and is in good body condition.

He has some hair in his ears but no sign of infection. Later, he will need to have his hair plucked as part of his grooming. The hair around his eyes will also need to be trimmed.

Handle his ears and eyes, mouth and paws as discussed to get him used to being handled. When bathing him, place cotton balls in his ears to minimize water getting in them. Remove the cotton balls after the baths. Use the Relief Shampoo and Creme Rinse as directed 1-2 times a month for the itching.

Puppy teeth look good.

Heart and lungs are clear; no murmur.

Abdomen palpated normal; 2 testicles descended.

No live fleas found. In addition to the Relief Shampoo and Creme Rinse, we will use a topical spray for the itching:

Rx: GenOne (Gentocin) Topical Spray --- Apply to affected areas on his sides 1-2 times a day as needed for itching...tnt

If he continues to be itchy with flea control, topical spray and Relief Shampoo, we will consider skin supplement and oral medications.

We dewormed him for round and hookworms. If he has a lot of worms, he may pass them in his stool or even vomit. Let us know if any noted.

We gave the first distemper-parvo vaccine on his left shoulder. He may be sore or tired for the next couple of days. Please let us know if lethargy or problems.

Unless problems, schedule a treatment appointment in 2 weeks for the second deworming and courtesy Advantage application (you may bathe him a day or two before the appointment).

Next exam and vaccines in 3 to 4 weeks. Plan for his neuter in about 2 months.
