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### **Client Notes for Taro Asari for 06/13/09:**

**Taro's Weight: 66.8 Lbs**

Taro looks great with the haircut and weightloss. He weighs 66.8 pounds and is moving well. His ears are stable with the cleaning and oral prednsione. Eyes look good. Monitor for the discharge; may be part of his allergies. If the discharge worsens or if his eyes get red (conjunctivitis), we may need to add on topical eye medication. None needed at this time.

The growth in his mouth is slightly larger compared to 2 months ago. It appears to be crossing over the midline of the roof of his mouth --- it started on the left side and crossing to the right side. It is still not bothering him and no sign of trauma (i.e. him biting it).

The growth does not seem to be impinging on the nasal passage. However, let us know if sneezing worsens or if swelling noted around the nose.

Continue to montior and let us know if any eating difficulty, blood etc....

We drained the fluid cyst by the base of his left ear; clear fluid.

Keep him on the current medications:

1. Prednisone 20 mg 1/2 tablet every other day.
2. clean ears daily with T8 Solution.
3. SynoviG3 Chews 1 chew twice daily. Let us know when low and we can refill with Phycos Chews.
4. 3V Caps: 1 once daily

Unless problems, schedule a follow-up in 2 months; he will be due for a small blood test to monitor his liver and kidneys (due to the steroids)....tnt
